## Strategy Work

Reading and strategy work is usually done daily. Focus on one strategy each session.

- 1. What are you wondering about as you read the story? Write down a question that you have.
- 2. What are you reminded of as you read? Note down a connection. You can connect to another book as well as to your own experiences.
- 3. Visualize: Create pictures in your mind as you read. Try creating (drawing/colouring/painting) an illustration.
- 4. Predict: What do you think is going to happen next in the story? Write down a prediction.
- 5. Sequence: Keep track of important events in the story. Note down important events on a timeline.
- 6. Summarize: Explain what is happening in the story to a family member or try writing a short summary.
